Your chances of **successful treatment** are better when cancer is **found early** through **annual clinical breast exam** and **mammogram**.

There are **FREE and LOW-COST** exams available if you:

- Are **40 years old or older**
- Have **low income**
- Have **medical insurance that does not cover these services**
- Have a **high insurance deductible/co-payment**
- Are **not getting these services through Medi-Cal/ other government-sponsored program**
- **Live in California**

If you are diagnosed with breast cancer, you may also qualify for **FREE** treatment.
